► OPENED A VIRTUAL LEARNING CENTER DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC, EXPANDED TO SERVE 15 SCHOOLS IN 3 DISTRICTS

The ELEVATE! Virtual Learning Center provided a comprehensive afterschool program for K-8 students who attend Old West End, Martin Luther King, and Robinson elementary schools. Using online technology, the innovative program achieved results in literacy and math performance, increased engagement in education and enrichment activities, and success in the development of leadership skills for children enrolled in the program.

► DEVELOPED A SIGNATURE CURRICULUM AND A REPLICABLE MODEL FOR IMPLEMENTING AFTERSCHOOL EDUCATION PROGRAMS

Building on the successes of the Virtual Learning Center, COHFS CEO Tracee Perryman developed ELEVATE!, an 8-month signature curriculum and training program for implementing this successful afterschool education program for children in urban and suburban centers. The multicultural curriculum is suitable for instruction in online environments and in learning centers nationwide and full training support is provided.
